NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Knoxville hereby acknowledges the unfortunate health issues caused by a Myalgic Encephalomyelitis- Chronic Fatigue Syndrome and that it may have debilitating effects on those suffering.

SECTION 2: The Council of the City of Knoxville hereby encourages businesses and members of the public to recognize May 12 as Myalgic Encephalomyelitis- Chronic Fatigue Syndrome Awareness Day.
