Did you know?



700,000 people in the UK, or 1 in 100 people, have ME.



Around 80% of people with ME are women.



At least 1 in 4 people with ME is housebound or bedbound.



There is no single test to diagnose ME, no cure and no universally effective treatment.



People with ME have lower quality of life measurements than any other disease tested.



70% of GPs interviewed thought ME was rare, despite higher prevalence than MS or Parkinson's.



88% of medical students surveyed reported not being taught about ME.
